CITIZENSHIP MARK GUIDELINES
(Board Policy 5132, Student Conduct Code, 7-12)

Course Title: Math-7 Common Core Teacher: R. Davis

1. Attends class daily. *Three or more unexcused absences will result in an unsatisfactory citizenship mark.*

2. Comes to class on time. *Five or more unexcused tardies in a quarter will result in an unsatisfactory citizenship mark.*

3. Comes to class with necessary materials.
Any student who fails to bring necessary materials three or more times will receive an unsatisfactory citizenship mark.

4. Completes homework assignments.
A limit of three late assignments will be accepted during the semester unless excused by the teacher.

5. Meets deadlines.
A limit of three late assignments will be accepted during the semester unless excused by the teacher.

6. Does own work when independent work is required: does not cheat.
Any student who cheats will be given an office referral and an unsatisfactory citizenship mark.

7. Exercises reasonable care of school property.
Destruction of school property will result in an office referral and an unsatisfactory citizenship mark.

8. Shows respect for others.
1st violation = warning / in class consequences
2nd violation = discussion with student/detention
3rd violation = detention and / or parent notification / possible office referral
4th violation = office referral and unsatisfactory citizenship mark

9. Does not disrupt class; exercises good conduct.
same as above

10. Other rules unique to this classroom:
Any student involved in a major citizenship infraction may be sent directly to the office with a referral.

EXPECTATIONS FOR OUTSTANDING CITIZENSHIP MARKS
