Types of evaluation and Weighted Value:

HOMEWORK / DAILY ASSIGNMENTS -

10-15 points

PARTICIPATION - 10 points

Homework Practices (including frequency)

Reading will be done frequently: In class assignments and homework.

Students will also have writing assignments, questions and worksheets to complete at home.

Homework is generally assigned 2-3 times per week.

Method of Grading and Scale:

All points are added together then averaged.

100 - 90 = A      59 - 0 = F

89 - 80 = B

79 - 70 = C

69 - 60 = D

Other:

This class requires students to read from the literature book, district literature lists, to write often and complete compositions. Students are expected to work independently and in peer groups.

Participation is a part of final grades.
