MATERIALS

ACADEMIC GRADE

Each student's grade is based on the total points accumulated during each grading period. When class assignments are given they are to be completed. If you do not understand an assignment, it is your responsibility to ask for help. There should never be any scribbling or doodles on assignments turned in for a grade. The grading scale will be:

90 - 100% = A

80 - 89 % = B

70 - 79 % = C

60 - 69% = D

0 - 59% = F

CITIZENSHIP GRADE

The following criteria shall be used in determining your citizenship grade:
