1. **Attends class daily.** Three or more unexcused absences will result in an unsatisfactory citizenship mark.
2. **Comes to class on time.** Five or more unexcused tardies in a quarter will result in an unsatisfactory citizenship mark.
3. **Comes to class with necessary materials.** Bring Instrument, Music, Binder and Pencil everyday.
4. **Completes homework assignments.** Due on time and complete.
5. **Meets deadlines.** Assignments will not be accepted after the due date.
6. **Does own work when independent work is required; does not cheat.** Students will keep their eyes on their own papers during tests and quizzes. Practice cards will be a true, honest and accurate record of the home practice of a student.
7. **Exercises reasonable care of school property.** Students will be charged for the replacement of defaced or damaged music stands, chairs, instruments and other materials and equipment in the music rooms.
8. **Shows respect for others.** Show maturity in speech and action and be sensitive to the needs of others.
9. **Does not disrupt class; exercises good conduct.** Raise your hand to be recognized to speak or move. Do not play or talk between songs.
10. **Other rules unique to this classroom:** No gum, candy, food, soft drinks, hats, sunglasses or visible cell phones.

**Expectations for outstanding citizenship marks:**

The student must:

- Exhibit exemplary behavior
- Play to the best of his/her ability
- Attend required concerts and assemblies,
- Show an advanced understanding of the musicianship and teamwork that is required to excel in group performance.
