CITIZENSHIP MARK GUIDELINES  
(Board Policy 5132, Student Conduct Code, 7-12)

Course Title: Math 7 Teacher: Mr. Wong

1. Attends class daily. *Three or more unexcused absences will result in an unsatisfactory citizenship mark.*
2. Comes to class on time. *Five or more unexcused tardies in a quarter will result in an unsatisfactory citizenship mark. The student must be in his or her seat by the end of the tardy bell to avoid a tardy. There are no warnings for tardies.*  
1<sup>st</sup> Tardy: 30 minute detention with the teacher 2<sup>nd</sup> Tardy: 60 minute detention 3<sup>rd</sup> Tardy or More: 60-90 min. detention
3. Comes to class with necessary materials.  
The student must check with the teacher if he or she is missing materials.
4. Completes homework assignments.  
All assignments (whether completed or not) are collected on Friday.  
Students may receive after-school homework time for not turning in work on Friday.
5. Meets deadlines.  
Work that is more than ONE week old receives a penalty. Example: a B+ grade now becomes a C+ grade.
6. Does own work when independent work is required: does not cheat.  
Students receive a warning about cheating; any incident of cheating after the warning will require a Conduct Code consequence.
7. Exercises reasonable care of school property.  
Students will repair or replace damaged classroom items such as desk numbers.
8. Shows respect for others.  
Students will keep offensive comments and gestures to themselves.
9. Does not disrupt class; exercises good conduct.

10. Other rules unique to this classroom:  
No social talking from tardy bell to dismissal bell.  
Work until the dismissal bell rings.
